The Environmental Management Division of Public Works is recommending the approval of the grant application to the United States Environmental Protection Agency. This grant application will provide additional funding to support the existing Particulate Matter (PM 2.5) Ambient Monitoring Network.

Public Works is seeking two-year grant funding in the amount of \$180,000.00 (\$90,000 per project year). No Match is required. The grant is on a reimbursement basis. The source of the estimated total project costs of \$180,000.00 is the Environmental Management Division's Air Quality operating budgets for FY 20, FY 21 and FY 22.
