<p>Summary The proposed updates in this item align Pinellas County’s fireworks rules with state law (Florida Statute 791.08) by allowing consumer use of fireworks on July 4th, New Year’s Eve, and New Year’s Day. They also eliminate the permit requirement for consumer or residential fireworks use on those designated holidays.</p> <p>Fiscal Impact This has no fiscal impact on Pinellas County as consumer permits were not previously being obtained or enforced for the designated holidays.</p>
