Penny covers cost of more than 70% of local government capital projects

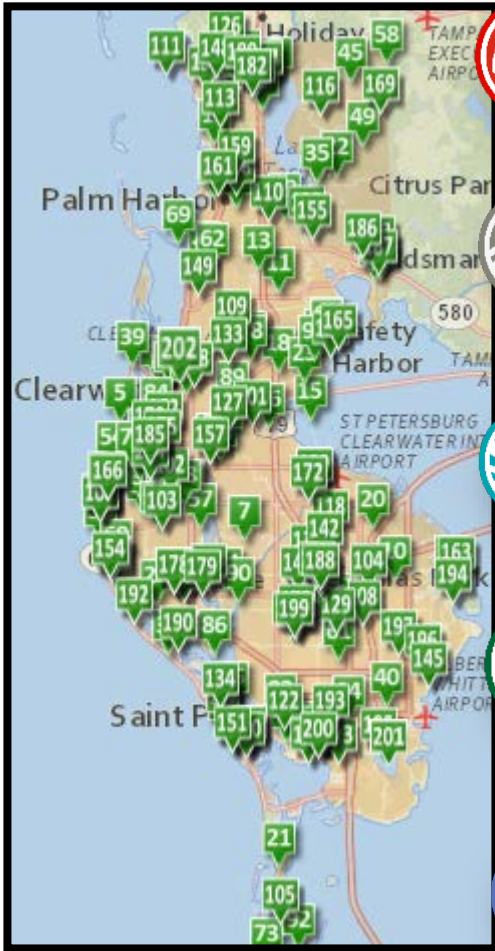

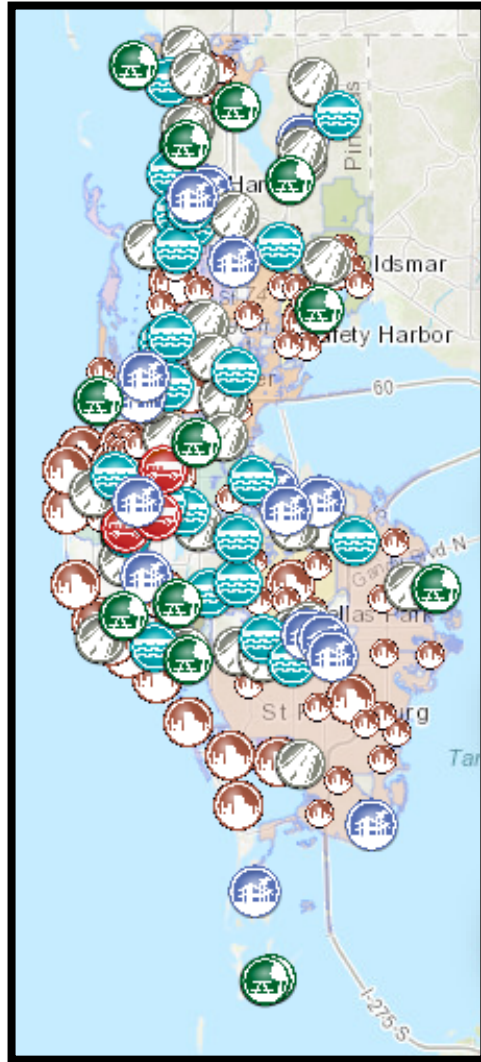
