The proposed Preservation category is intended to recognize natural resource features worthy of preservation and those areas of the county that are now used, or are appropriate to be used, for the conservation, production, and management to the regional potable water supply and the supporting infrastructure, consistent with the natural resources of the area.

AN OPDINANCE AMENDING THE COUNTYWIDE PLAN MAP OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, BY ACTION ON CASE NUMBER CW 20-20 INITIATED BY THE CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG AND TRANSMITTED TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ITS CAPACITY AS THE COUNTYMIDE PLANNING AUTHORITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SPECIAL ACT, PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT TO THE PLAN, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The current Residential Medium category is used to depict areas that are primarily well-suffer for medium-density residential uses at a maximum density of 15 dwelling units per acre. The proposed Multimodal Corridor category is intended to recognize those corridors of critical importance to the movement of people and goods throughout he county and that are served by multiple modes of transport, including automobile, bus, bicycle, rail, and/or pedestrian. This category is intended to include those transportation conditors connecting Activity Centers, characterized by mixed-use development, and in particular, supported by and designed to facilitate transit.

In review of the Ordinances above, there may be modifications that arise at the public hearing and/or with other responsible parties.

Forward Pinellas has made an advisory recommendation to the CPA for each proposed amendment. The subsequent action of the CPA may amend the Countywide Plan Map from the existing plan category to another plan category, as may be determined appropriate based on the public hearings and consistent with the Countywide Plan and procedures related therein.
