## **Description & Comments**

The Human Services Department requests Board approval for acceptance of this grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The Notice of Award (NOA) reflects the second year of a 3-year commitment to continuation of the Pinellas County Navigator Program for outreach and enrollment assistance to uninsured and/or underinsured residents throughout the county. The 3-year grant award period is September 2, 2015 through September 1, 2018, and the project budget is \$580,000 per year, for a total of \$1,740,000 in federal funds. The budget period for year 2 begins September 2, 2016 and ends September 1, 2017. Funding for year 3 will be issued through an annual non-competing continuation award, conditional upon timely submission of application, strong performance and funding availability.

The \$580,000 in grant revenue and expense was anticipated and included in the FY17 Budget. No local match is required. The grant pays for contracted staff, supplies and related travel. Separate funding for the Program Coordinator is provided through the Health Care for the Homeless Program Grant from HHS. Prior to this 3-year grant award, the County received two 1-year awards, so this is the fourth year of funding for the Navigator Program.
