My name is Michael Hicks. I am here today with my neighbors Michael Sapp and Rick White to support my comments.

I want to thank Commissioner Brian Scott for assisting me in understanding how to speak to you today.

As well, I thank him for his efforts over the past several weeks to address our needs internally with the utilities department.

We are here to request your immediate assistance with the low water pressure of our reclaimed water service in Westlake Village.

Many in our community, including myself, have contacted the Utilities Department several times over at least the past year about this problem. They have not improved upon the problem in the least during the last 18 months or so. In fact, it has become more severe.

Westlake is located in North County near Belcher Road and Nebraska Avenue and consists of roughly 650 single family homes.... on large lots.

I have submitted a Master package of materials which contains signed statements of 31 Homeowners supporting my

remarks today that for at least the past year we have not received reclaimed water at sufficient pressure to operate our in-ground sprinkler systems.

As a result, as a community, we have sustained irreparable damages to our lawns and landscaping.

Most of us have lost most of our lawns and many of our plantings.

Assuming an average lawn replacement cost of even only \$5,000 per home at 80% of our 650 homes results in an eye watering community loss of \$2,600,000.

I have included in our Master package representative photos of several damaged lawns in front yards. Most back yards are worse.

I have the following questions, comments and requests to bring to your attention.

I do not understand why or how a low "SUPPLY" of water results in low water "PRESSURE." We would be better off with no water than water at such low pressure that it will not operate our sprinkler systems. At least if we have NO water, we can pursue other solutions. This way we are caught in a web of complicated day and time restrictions as well as fines by the county AND our Homeowners Association.

We have been without pressure for at least a year. It is not responsible that we are now advised that it "may" improve by 10% in 30 days. What are we to do with our dead lawns by then? What are we to do about our HOA fines?

Why are we continuing to be charged \$63 bi-monthly for a "service/product" that is not being provided to us?

This constitutes 28% of my bi-monthly water bill (copy attached). Is that even legal, let alone morally responsible?

For example, one would not continue to pay for monthly cable TV if one's cable did not provide the programming for which one was paying.

It is inexplicable that reclaimed water meters are presently being installed in our community when there is such low flow to measure. Respectfully, I ask, "How much more can we be charged for a service we are not receiving?" This money should instead be devoted to fix our low pressure.

Why were so many homes permitted to be added to the system that its design capability was exceeded thus depriving both existing customers as well as those new customers of the service/product for which they are paying?

Originally we were permitted to water as many days per week as we wished.

As the cost of reclaimed water service steadily increased over the past years, the watering days were more and more restricted. Thus, similar to shrinkflation, we are paying more, for less.

If we cannot receive the reclaimed water for which we are paying, the following options should be immediately evaluated and implemented:

- a. Confirm if reclaimed customers can instead use potable water to irrigate their lawns once per week. (I have not been able to determine from the website if this is permitted.)
- b. Suspend billings for reclaimed water until it can be provided at proper full pressure
- c. Consider providing refunds or future credits to customers who for the past year have paid for reclaimed water they did not receive.
- d. Allow customers who switch to potable water to switch back to reclaimed without any costs or fees if/when these reclaimed problems are resolved
- e. Consider a county ordinance with more specific provisions than those in present rather vague Florida State law allowing Florida Friendly landscaping plans to "override" HOA lawn provisions.
- f. Initiate a FREE educational program countywide to teach homeowners how to attractively and effectively convert large portions of their existing water hungry lawns to Florida Friendly plantings instead

In conclusion, we need your immediate assistance to save what little may be left of our lawns and landscapes.

I request that you add a monthly item to your Agenda requiring the Director of Utilities to report to you on the progress made to restore our reclaimed water pressure.

Over the last three years, demand for reclaimed water has rapidly increased. In years past, the William E. Dunn Water Reclamation Facility in Palm Harbor delivered approximately 10 million gallons of reclaimed water per day. It's now distributing more than 16 million gallons per day across North County. This is significant because our reclaimed systems rely solely on the volume of wastewater received to produce reclaimed water. Right now, the William E. Dunn Water Reclamation Facility is only

producing around 6 million gallons of reclaimed water per day.

Because of this, North County faces significant challenges when it comes to balancing supply and demand. Reductions in wastewater flows required for producing reclaimed water coupled with excessive overuse and overwatering by customers puts a significant strain on the system leading to low pressure experiences.

TONLY PERMITTER I REVIEW. IMPOSSIBLE TO OVERUSE/OVERWHER Reclaimed water restrictions are implemented to ensure equitable distribution among customers, especially during supply shortages. To address this, PCU is enforcing watering restrictions to manage usage effectively to ensure everyone has access to reclaimed water.

PCU has taken several short-term steps to address this issue, including: RECEASINE WATER

- Adding pumps into service to increase water pressure.
- Installing air release valves throughout Palm Harbor to remove air from lines and improve pressure.
- Increasing service line flushing and filter inspections to ensure there is no debris obstructing the lines.

HAPED.

Long term, we are improving off-site pump stations to allow for enhanced distributing and pressure throughout the system, adding a new pump station that will improve pressure and flow for customers on the east side of Lake Tarpon, and increasing reclaimed water supply through a managed aquifer storage and recovery system with Lake Tarpon as a water source.

While we want to assure you we are actively addressing this issue, we need everyone's help in conserving water to alleviate the current stress on the system. There are several steps you can take to make a difference:

- **Know your <u>watering schedule and rules</u>**. Reclaimed water usage is not permitted in North County between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Implement outdoor water conservation and Florida-Friendly practices. Install smart irrigation sensors to turn off your water when we do get rain. Also, adding mulch to reduce evaporation when you do water your lawn can reduce the amount of water needed in your landscaping by as much as 50%.
- **Sign up for the** <u>Utilities Customer Portal</u>: As digital meters are installed across our service area, every customer can see real-time water usage and access tools to address excessive water use and leaks in your irrigation system.
