 - Approval of grant awards from HRSA for the HCH Program.
- **Background:**
 - On November 18, 2014, the Board approved a grant award in the amount of ٠ \$581,256.00 and authorized the County Administrator to approve additional HRSA grant funding.
 - HRSA, through the Notice of Award dated May 20, 2015, notified the County of a change • in the budget period end date to February 29, 2016.

Doing Things!

Grant Awards from the U.S. Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA) for the Healthcare for the Homeless (HCH) Program-Human Services (cont.)

Budgetary Impact:

- Notice of Award (8-18-15) of \$148,790.00 for one-time grant supplement recognizes demonstrated improvement in access, quality of care and value of care in 2014.
- Notice of Award (9-10-15) of \$248,872.00 for Expanded Services supports expansion of primary care services to include evening and weekend hours at the Safe Harbor Shelter.
- Notice of Award (9-21-15) of \$54,424.00 increases the ongoing Base Funding level.
- After increases, total grant funding for the budget period is **\$1,463,842.00**.

Value Impact:

From January 1, 2015 through September 30, 2015, the HCH program served 1,794 unduplicated patients. The unduplicated patient target for the calendar year 2015 is 2,390 unduplicated patients.
