Agreement to terminate Cooperative Funding Agreement 19CG0001790 between Pinellas County and Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD). Agreement 19CG0001790 was intended to provide construction funding in the amount of \$357,571.00 for County project 002123A - Roosevelt Creek Channel 5 Improvements. The County was unable to award the construction bid by the date specified in this agreement, April 30th, 2019. The County advertised the project for bids, but qualified bids were too high, and the County had to reject them. The lowest bid was 86% higher than the engineer's estimate.

Project plans and engineer's estimate have been modified which should result in a successful bid. The County and SWFWMD are terminating existing agreement 19CG0001790. The County is resubmitting a request for funding through SWFWMD's FY22 Cooperative Funding Initiative (CFI).

002123A - Roosevelt Creek Channel 5 Improvements is included in the Capital Improvement Program FY22-FY27 6-Year Plan. The 6-Year Plan reflects the anticipated \$350,000.00 SWFWMD CFI funding.

- Funds from SWFWMD agreement 19CG0001790 were not spent.
