

RESOLUTION NO. 26-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR AS THE DESIGNEE OF THE HEAD OF THE PUBLIC ENTITY FOR COMPLIANCE DECISIONS UNDER 28 CFR PART 35 SUBPART H — WEB AND MOBILE ACCESSIBILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act Title II Regulations provides that no qualified individual with a disability shall, on the basis of disability, be excluded from participation in or be denied the benefits of the services, programs, or activities of a public entity, or be subjected to discrimination by any public entity; and

WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act Title II Regulations has adopted the WCAG 2.1 AA requirements under 28 CFR Part 35 – Subpart H — Web and Mobile Accessibility, as the standard of compliance for web and mobile accessibility for state and local government entities; and

WHEREAS, when a public entity can demonstrate that compliance under 28 CFR § 35.200 would result in a fundamental alteration of the nature of a service, program, or activity, or an undue financial or administrative burden, the decision that compliance would result in such alteration or burden must be made by the head of a public entity or its designee, and must be accompanied with a written statement of the reasons for reaching that conclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as head of a public entity, desires to designate the County Administrator as its designee to make decisions regarding compliance under 28 CFR §35.204;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, at a duly assembled meeting held on this 21st day of April, 2026, as follows:

- Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners, as head of a public entity, designates the County Administrator as its designee for compliance decisions necessary under 28 CFR §35.204.
- Section 2. As designee, the County Administrator is authorized to further delegate responsibilities as appropriate to fulfill all obligations and duties under 28 CFR Part 35 – Subpart H — Web and Mobile Accessibility.
- Section 3. This Resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
