## **Description & Comments**

There are two corresponding Granicus items, 23-1843A and 23-1845A, which are supplements of 23-0253A and 23-0257A. Both relate to grant funding for project 004541A ATMS North County Phase 2. See their descriptions below.

**23-1843A:** Supplemental No. 1 to the State funded Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation, providing construction and construction engineering inspection services for the Advanced Traffic Management System/Intelligent Transportation System project on State Road 580 / Skinner/Main from U.S. Alternate 19/State Road 580/Broadway to U.S. 19.

Supplemental No. 1 Agreement to the State funded Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), providing construction and construction engineering inspection services for the Advanced Traffic Management System/Intelligent Transportation System project on State Road (SR) 580 / Skinner/Main from U.S. Alternate 19/SR 580/Broadway to U.S. 19. Originally, FDOT was providing \$334,500.00, with a County match of \$1,785,648.00, for a total segment estimate of \$2,120,148.00. The segment estimate has increased to \$2,166,582.00, FDOT funding for this segment has increased to \$1,083,291.00, County match has decreased and is now estimated at \$1,083,291.00.

**23-1845A:** Supplemental No. 1 to the State funded Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation, providing construction and construction engineering inspection for the Advanced Traffic Management System /Intelligent Transportation System project on State Road 586/Causeway Boulevard/Curlew Road from Honeymoon Park entrance to U.S. 19.

Supplemental No. 1 Agreement to the State funded Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), providing construction and construction engineering inspection for the Advanced Traffic Management System /Intelligent Transportation System project on State Road 586/Causeway Boulevard/Curlew Road from the Honeymoon Park entrance to U.S. 19. Originally, FDOT was providing \$502,000.00, with a County match of \$1,771,345.00, for a total segment estimate of \$2,273,345.00. The segment estimate has increased to \$2,709,064.00, FDOT funding for this segment has increased to \$1,354,532.00, County match has decreased and is now estimated at \$1,354,532.00.

The County's match for both segments combined was previously estimated at \$3,556,993.00. It is now estimated at \$2,437,823.00, a decrease of \$1,119,170.00.

County match is budgeted in the Adopted Capital Six Year Plan at \$3,597,000.00 funded by Local Option Fuel Tax. FDOT contribution is budgeted at \$836,000.00. The County's Capital Plan will be updated during the budget cycle to reflect the changes to County match and FDOT grant funding.
