# Pinellas County

*The current number of missing meals in Pinellas is **23,610,710***

- FTB provided more than **14.35 Million Meals** to Pinellas County in the last fiscal year
- Current goal of **35 Million Meals in 2020-21** to be distributed in Pinellas County (Goal increased from **18.7 Million Meals** pre-COVID)
- We proudly serve with **59 agency partners** including St. Pete Free Clinic, Hope Villages of America (RCS), Helping Hands, Liberty Church, Daystar Life Center, Florida Dream Center, Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas & West Pasco, and Clearwater Free Clinic



# CARES & Tampa Bay Resiliency Fund Impact

- Distributed **1,772,343 Meals** to Pinellas County through CARES and Tampa Bay Resiliency Fund
- Average of **904 Families** served at our weekly Mega Distribution at Tropicana Field
  - Peak of **1,200-1,600 Families** served weekly, currently averaging around 600 (since Jan 2021)
  - Each family receives nearly **50 lbs** of nutritious and healthy food

# Distribution Programs

## Mega Distribution

- Weekly distribution every Saturday morning at Tropicana Field, serving an average of **904 Families** families weekly since April 2020

## Meals on the Go

- Weekly distribution at Feeding Pinellas Empowerment Center serving **300 Families** a week. Meals are made by FRESHforce, our workforce development program

## Groceries on the Go

- The only SNAP approved mobile grocery store in Florida

## Health Partners

- BayPines VA Healthcare, Largo Medical and Community Health Centers of Pinellas

## School Pantries

- Hollins High, Lakewood High, Johns Hopkins Middle School, Campbell Park Elementary and Melrose Elementary and Oak Grove Middle (in partnership with Hispanic Outreach Center)
