**Date/Time/Comments:** 05/13/2019 Approval and execution of SAMHSA grant award for the Pinellas County Adult Drug Court Project with the Sixth Judicial Circuit and Funding Agreement with WestCare Gulfcoast-Florida, Inc. (WestCare). Reviewed prior funding agreement 18-2017A with Westcare for reference. Limits above are the as prior due to similar scope and for consistency. Agency must sign Data Sharing Agreement with County.

**NOTES:** This grant award will allow for the expansion of the capacity of the Pinellas County Adult Drug Court. The project seeks to reduce crime and substance abuse among high risk, high need offenders who have experienced trauma, at-risk of opioid overdose and may also have a co-occurring mental illness. Over a five (5)-year period, Adult Drug Court will serve 295 more unduplicated drug-involved offenders through the grant funds. This number represents a 25% increase overall in treatment participation for Adult Drug Court. The grant award is \$400,000.00 per year over five years for a total of \$2,000,000.00. No cost match is required. Under the Funding Agreement with WestCare, they will incorporate evidence-based programs and practices within the delivery of the planned substance abuse treatment services for Adult Drug Court participants. A multi-disciplinary treatment team comprised of substance use disorder counselors and a peer recovery coach, along with a research assistant will ensure there is client focused care and rigorous data analysis for programming assessment.
