Dear Chairwoman Peters,

We write to express our commitment to supporting Pinellas County as it ensures local hospitals can immediately participate in the hospital directed payment program (DPP).

By signing this letter, we agree to take any actions required by Pinellas County, provided that the County's legal counsel has agreed that such actions are in accordance with all relevant laws and regulations, as it adopts a hospital special assessment ordinance and levies a special assessment rate supporting an intergovernmental transfer for directed payment program Year 3. Timely rate passage will enable hospitals in our area—which falls in Medicaid Managed Care Region 5—to obtain a uniform increase in the rate of Medicaid reimbursement for Medicaid services provided to Floridians from October 1, 2022, until September 30, 2023.

In addition to supporting the County as it unlocks this Year 3 opportunity, we commit to supporting both the state and the county government as they work to allow Region 5 hospitals to partake in the DPP for the next program year and any future year in which the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services approves this program.

We remain deeply committed to serving Florida's indigent population. We are grateful for the state's willingness to help us sustain that mission by exploring novel funding solutions like the DPP. We look forward to partnering with you to unlock this and similar funding opportunities for years to come.


