Pinellas: Applications sought for Unincorporated Seminole Sports Association

Applications Due by 3 p.m. March 8, 2024

Applications are now being accepted for four citizen appointments to the Unincorporated Seminole Sports Association (USSA). These appointments are for two-year terms, beginning on the date of appointment.

The purpose of the Unincorporated Seminole Sports Association is to provide resources to serve the recreational needs of the unincorporated Seminole area. It was created by an ordinance passed by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners.

The Unincorporated Seminole Sports Association is made up of 7 members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, who are qualified Pinellas County electors:

- Four at-large directors each of whom resides within the Unincorporated Seminole Youth Sports District and are not associated as board members with the Cross Bayou Athletic Association, Seminole Youth Athletic Association, or Seminole Junior Warhawks Athletic Association.
- One director who is nominated by the Cross Bayou Athletic Association Board of Directors,
- One director who is nominated by the Seminole Junior Warhawks Athletic Association Board of Directors,
- One director who is nominated by the Seminole Youth Athletic Association Board of Directors,

Meetings are held the third Wednesday of every month at 7:00 p.m. at the SYAA Board Room located at 12100 90th Avenue, Seminole, Florida.

Applications are due by **3 p.m. on Friday, March 8, 2024**. The application can be found at www.pinellas.gov/boards. The Board of County Commissioners will review all applications and make their selection at the April 9, 2024, Board of County Commissioners meeting. The appointments will be selected by the Board of County Commissioners as a whole.
