### Description & Comments

The Crime Stoppers Trust Fund grant award program engages the community, law enforcement and the media in a unified attempt to reduce crime. The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) houses the Crime Stoppers of Pinellas, Inc. program and manages all programmatic and financial aspects of the grant award. This award allocation of \$189,151.43 supports salary costs for the Crime Stoppers Coordinator, operating expenses, crime tip rewards, and media campaigns from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026. No match is required.

A budget amendment will not be needed for this grant. The County includes anticipated grant funds in the Sheriff's annual budget to allow for increased funds for the Sheriff without going through the budget amendment process. Funding is only provided when a grant is obtained.
