Summary:

Plaintiff was injured when a semi-trailer truck driven by a Pinellas County employee side swiped her car, in which her young child was a passenger. Plaintiff's car was totaled. The Pinellas County driver admitted liability and was cited with careless driving. He was subsequently terminated from employment for reasons unrelated to this accident. Plaintiff, who happens to be a Clerk employee, underwent back surgery for the injuries related to the accident. Plaintiff, who could not work following her surgery, received short-term disability benefits as a member of the UPS system; the County is not entitled to reimbursement or subrogation for short-term disability benefits paid.

Plaintiff's medical bills total \$201,672.05. The statutory cap on this case is \$200,000.00 for Plaintiff's claim. Plaintiff is willing to release any claims that could be brought on behalf of her minor child. Such claims would raise the statutory cap to \$300,000.00.

Settlement in the amount of \$180,000.00 includes a release for her claim as well as any claim her minor child may have.

It is recommended that the proposed \$180,000.00 settlement be accepted. Risk Management and County Administration concur with this recommendation.
