

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PINELLAS COUNTY CODE**

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to amend the Pinellas County Code by Ordinance.

The public hearing on the Ordinance will be held on **Tuesday, July 21, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.**, in-person and virtually. In accordance with the Executive Office of the Governor Orders 20-69, 20-91 20-112 and 120-139, and Pinellas County Emergency Official Authority Order 20-3, the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners will hold an in-person public meeting with virtual participation.

To enable social distancing, this meeting will be held in the Magnolia Room at the Pinellas County Cooperative Extension, 12520 Ulmerton Road, Largo Florida, with offsite participants utilizing Communications Media Technology (CMT) on the Zoom platform.

PROVIDING THAT THE PINELLAS COUNTY CODE BE
AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 2-142 OF SAID CODE;
PROVIDING THAT THE RISK FINANCE ORDINANCE BE
AMENDED TO MODIFY THE PROCEDURE FOR
DEMANDS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;
PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION OF THE CODE;
APPROVING AND REJECTING SETTLEMENT
DEMANDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
