Description & Comments

Human Services is requesting pproval of the ranking of firms and agreement with the number one ranked firm, athenahealth, Inc. for Electronic Health Record (EHR) for Low Income and Homeless Healthcare Programs - Human Services ARPA, as needed by the Business Technology Services Department (BTS) and Human Services.

- This contract will provide for a modern EHR to allow for proactive health service delivery, community care coordination, service planning, oversight, decision support, and effective communication and patient engagement.
- Eleven submittals were received, with BTS and HS recommending award to the top ranked firm athenahealth, Inc. for EHR for Low Income and Homeless Healthcare Programs.
- The contract has a term of ten years with a not-to-exceed value of \$3,507,208.75; This amount includes \$55,983.75 in unspecified funds.
- Funding in the amount of \$5,700,000.00 for the first year of this contract is included in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Adopted Budget and the FY25 Proposed Budget in the ARPA Fund. This \$5.7M is a combination of 3 contracts with 2 vendors and the attached contract with Athenahealth. Funding for future years will need to be proposed at the appropriate time.

Contract No. 24-0330-RFP(AJM): not-to-exceed contract value of \$3,507,208.75 for the duration of the ten-year contract. Authorize the Chairman to sign and the Clerk of the Circuit Court to attest.

Fiscal Impact:

Estimated 10-year expenditure not-to-exceed: \$3,507,208.75 for Athenahealth. \$5,700,000.00 is included in the FY24 Adopted Budget, but has been carried forward in the FY25 Proposed Budget due to contract approval timing.

Funding is appropriated through BTS and Human Services Departments Tentative Budgets within American Rescue Plan Act Fund
