All of you know that I have worked for a long time leading the grass roots efforts to bring county funding to the greater Seminole area. I'm writing to give you more knowledge of Richard Masi who has applied for the open seat on the Greater Seminole Recreation Board. Seminole Junior Warhawks Athletic Association (SJWAA) does lie within the boundaries of the taxing district. In fact, in discussion with Seminole Youth leadership, the district has given SJWAA monies in the past.
