

RESOLUTION NO. 24- 14

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, INDICATING THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' SUPPORT OF THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO LIGHT THE BOB GRAHAM SUNSHINE SKYWAY BRIDGE IN RECOGNITION OF CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH; GLOBAL CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY; NATIONAL GUN VIOLENCE AWARENESS WEAR ORANGE WEEKEND; JUNETEENTH; DOWN SYNDROME AWARENESS WEEK; AND PHELAN-MCDERMID SYNDROME AWARENESS DAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desire to indicate the Board's support for recognizing Child Abuse Prevention Month; Global Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Awareness Day; National Gun Violence Awareness Wear Orange Weekend; Juneteenth; Down Syndrome Awareness Week; and Phelan-McDermid Syndrome Awareness Day.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, at a duly assembled meeting held on this 5th day of March, 2024, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners desires to indicate support of the Florida Department of Transportation to light the Bob Graham Sunshine Skyway Bridge in recognition of:

- a) Child Abuse Prevention Month on March 31 – April 6, 2024;
- b) Global Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia Awareness Day on April 20, 2024;
- c) National Gun Violence Awareness Wear Orange Weekend on June 7, 2024;
- d) Juneteenth on June 19, 2024;
- e) Down Syndrome Awareness Week on October 8-13, 2024; and
- f) Phelan-McDermid Syndrome Awareness Day on October 22, 2024.

Section 2. It is the Board's intent that the above listed organizations and/or causes be deemed added to the list of previously approved organizations and/or causes set forth in Resolution No. 24-03, for which ongoing support is considered granted.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
