
Existing Use(s): Institutional uses, primarily a church

Proposed Use(s): Residential units






Surrounding Uses






Countywide Plan Map Designation







Local Actions

Initial Vote:

Community Planning and Preservation Commission Vote: 0-7 to deny

- Key Concerns:
 - Preservation of single-family character and neighborhood "sense of place."
 - Street pattern concerns.
- Appeal Vote

City Council Vote: 5-2 to approve

- Supportive Points:
 - Housing Need: Increased demand within St. Petersburg.
 - Transit Proximity: Importance of density near the SunRunner Bus Rapid Transit Station.
 - Comparable Areas: Similar developments in Snell Isle and Coquina Key.
 - Existing Zoning: Higher intensity developments already permitted nearby.
- Public Opposition: 17 public speakers, 86 emails of concern
 - Concerns about increased density and potential impacts on neighborhood character, increasing parking, traffic, and stormwater issues.



Recommendation

Proposed Countywide Plan Map Amendment Findings

- A. The Residential Medium category is appropriate for the proposed use of the property and is consistent with the criteria for utilization of this category.
- B. Despite initial opposition and a denial by the Community Planning and Preservation Commission, the City Council approved the amendment with a 5-2 vote, balancing community feedback with planning objectives.
- C. The proposed amendment either does not involve, or will not significantly impact, the remaining relevant countywide considerations.

Staff finds the proposed amendment consistent with the Relevant Countywide Considerations and recommends approval

Forward Pinellas and Planners Advisory Committee recommends approval
