<p>Comments: 7/24/20 Approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Funding Agreement with Suncoast Center, Inc. (Suncoast) for the Sexual Assault Victim Examination (SAVE) Program. This Agreement provides funding for the SAVE Program to conduct medical examinations for eligible victims of sexual assault. Funding in an amount not to exceed \$172,200.00 per year, for a total of \$861,000.00 over five (5) years, has been identified in the anticipated Human Services General Fund budget. This Agreement will commence October 1, 2020 and save expire September 30, 2025. Reviewed Agreement, Staff Report and prior Review from FY16, attached. Removed Auto and Umbrella limits. Risk is moderate and limits reflect this.</p>			
<p>Notes: This Agreement provides funding the SAVE Program to conduct medical examinations for eligible victims of sexual assault. The SAVE Program serves victims of non-caregiver sexual assault age 13 and over who reside or were assaulted in Pinellas County. Sexual assault victims are examined by an Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner (ARNP), Registered Nurse (RN), or a Medical Doctor (MD) employed by Suncoast. The Program provide necessary prophylactic medicine and supplies for clients as well as staff training and travel expenses for offsite or clinic-based medical exams. The practitioner can also provide expert witness testimony if a case proceeds to trial.</p> <p>The State of Florida Department of Health in Pinellas County provides lab testing in conjunction with the SAVE program. In addition, Suncoast works closely with law enforcement, the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office, and the State Attorney to ensure holistic coordination of services. The SAVE Program served 164 individuals in fiscal year (FY) 2019, and has provided services to 94 clients in the first two quarters of FY20.</p>
