This is a civil action in which Plaintiff alleges negligence against the County and seeks monetary damages for personal injuries allegedly arising out of a trip and fall on a pothole in the parking lot of the Belleair Boat Ramp on September 3, 2020, at or near 3900 W Bay Dr., Belleair Bluffs, Pinellas County, Florida.

Plaintiff's medical bills to date exceed \$75,000.00 and given the potential liability exposure, it is recommended that the County Attorney's office be authorized to accept the Plaintiff's Settlement in the amount of \$75,000.00, inclusive of all costs and claims for attorney's fees.

Approval of this settlement is recommended by Risk Management, County Administration, and the County Attorney's Office.
