Federally funded subaward and grant agreement from the Florida Division of Emergency Management for Federal Emergency Management Agency Region IV Hazard Mitigation Grant program funding for the replacement of span-wire-supported traffic signals with mast arm traffic signals.

The grant agreement is overrepresented in the CIP currently and will need to be adjusted during the next budget cycle. Grant was awarded in the amount of \$5,383,682.70 (65%), with a county match of \$2,930,317.30 (35%). Grant was programmed into the Proposed CIP in the amount of \$6,237,000.00 (75%), with a county match of \$2,077,000.00 (25%). The department will need to request an additional \$854,000.00 during the next budget cycle, or identify an existing source that can cover the additional funding required for the county match.
