This is an intent to apply for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program grant through the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM).

If awarded, this grant will benefit the County by allowing for the purchase of lands that could be used to build coastal resilience, improve water quality, and provide needed services to communities and the environment through building upon PID 005120A RESTORE grant SEP 16-3 Floodplain Land Acquisition award funds to purchase vulnerable lands and mitigate repetitive loss, from flooding and impacts from climate and sea level rise.

This grant will be single-year and single-departmental, which will likely impact Fiscal Year 2024. Public Works has already coordinated with FDEM.

This grant will be administered by Public Works in close coordination with FDEM.

The total application amount is \$9,963,168.00 with \$3,321,056.00 match required. There are other funding sources associated with this project, RESTORE Council Award GNSSP23FL0048, which will complete the total project budget of \$13,284,224.

This is not budgeted and would likely require a future budget amendment.

Based on the thresholds for delegated approval, this grant application will require Board approval to apply.
