This letter serves as the official promulgation of the 2025 update and revision to the Pinellas County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP).

Pinellas County Emergency Management, in collaboration with hundreds of municipal, local, county, state, federal, and non-governmental partner agencies completed the revision of the plan on October 6, 2025. The CEMP was found compliant with Rule Chapter 27P-6 Florida Administrative Code (FAC) and other criteria and was approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management on November 5, 2025.

The Board of County Commissioners, sitting in regular session on December 16, 2025 passed resolution 25-141 adopting the CEMP.

Effective immediately, this version of the CEMP is the official framework for how the County as a whole will prepare for, respond to, and recover from all hazards that could adversely affect the health, safety, and general welfare of residents and visitors.
