Summary:

This is for approval to adopt a Resolution extending waiving double the permit fee for building permits and construction in a floodplain within the unincorporated County and communities of Belleair Beach, Belleair Shore, Indian Rocks Beach, Oldsmar, Kenneth City, and Safety Harbor, submitted from December 31, 2025 through June 30, 2026, for after-the-fact permits for work already commenced or completed on storm damaged properties directly or indirectly, by Hurricane Helene or Hurricane Milton, subject to specific conditions.

Fiscal Impact.
