A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA; VACATING A PORTION OF BAYSHORE DRIVE RIGHT-OF-WAY, AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORDS BOOK 1881, PAGES 325 AND 326, LYING ADJACENT TO LOT 4, BLOCK 4, BAYHAVEN FIRST ADDITION SUBDIVISION, PLAT BOOK 60, PAGE 52, LYING WITHIN SECTION 30-30-15, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Michael S. Smith and Shawntee Smith, (the Petitioners) have petitioned this Board of County Commissioners to vacate the following described property:

Lands described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and by this reference made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioners have shown that the vacation of such portions of the plat will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision; and
