Baypointe Stormwater Conservation Area project is a regional project that consists of a proposed 40+ acre Stormwater management facility which will provide stormwater storage, flood protection and reduction, attenuation, treatment; habitat restoration, creation, and mitigation for considerable offsite drainage (202 acres). Once complete this project will create a more disaster resilient community and minimize inland or riverine flooding losses; ell as create future opportunities for public education. The proposed project will expand both the acreage of surface waters on the property as well as address regrading and system improvements which will provide flood ection and enhance public safety as repetitive localized flooding continues to occur as recent as late 2024. The proposed project will also expand the acreage of wetlands and prevent a significate amount of nitrogen from g discharged into coastal receiving waters per year.
