### Review & Comments

The OMB Grants Team has conducted a review of the **Human Services/ Sheriff** intent to apply for the **Crime Stoppers Trust Fund** funded by **Office of Attorney General of Florida**.

#### Project Scope of Work

The Crime Stoppers Trust Fund is a recurring annual grant that funds operational costs for the Pinellas County Crime Stoppers program. Crime Stoppers is a community-based program involving citizens, the media, and law enforcement in the fight against crime.

#### Benefit Summary

The FY25-26 Crime Stoppers Trust Fund Grant award is \$153,430.80 plus an additional \$35,720.64 in rollover funds from the FY23-24 Crime Stoppers grant, totaling \$189,151.44.

#### Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **multi-year** grant affecting **FY25** and **FY26**. This application request is for **\$189,151.44** with no cost share/match required.
