## **Qualification Requirements:**

ONLY 1 BCC CITIZEN APPOINTMENT. The governing body of the authority shall consist initially of three (3) members; two (2) members shall be appointed by the city council of Pinellas Park and one (1) member appointed by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners. Members shall serve a three-year term. Per the Special Act, members must be qualified residents of the District with outstanding reputations for civic pride, interest, integrity, responsibility and business ability, and cannot be an officer or employee of any city or of the county in any capacity, except elected officials.
