I am writing to urge the county to reconsider the number of dispensaries allowed in unincorporated Pinellas County as determined by the proposed ordinance. As commissioners I urge you to examine the impact marijuana dispensaries have had in states with similar laws and carefully craft regulations that minimize program abuses.

Research done by the marijuana industry suggests one dispensary per 67,222 residents. The state used this report to determine the number of licensees and other counties have used it to determine the number of dispensaries allowed to operate in their jurisdiction.

I urge you to consider using this research and amend the ordinance to reflect that equation. With approximately 280,848 residing within unincorporated Pinellas County, the more appropriate number of operating dispensaries would be 4 not 14 or 16.

To avoid another pill mill- like scenario, the county should consider limiting the number of marijuana dispensaries.
