WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor entered into an agreement on May 9, 2023, referred to as Pinellas County Contract No. 23-0083-RFP (hereinafter "Agreement"), pursuant to which the Contractor agreed to provide facilities landscape and irrigation services for the County; and

WHEREAS, Section thirty-six (36) "Amendment" of the Agreement permits modification by mutual written agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor now wish to modify the Agreement in order to provide for a contract extension and additional funds at the same prices, terms, and conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:

- 1. The Parties agree to exercise the first term extension, and extend the term of the agreement an additional twenty-four (24) months from May 9, 2026, to May 8, 2028.
- 2. Section 14 ("Compensation and Method of Payment"), subsection B ("Spending Cap and Payment Structure"), is removed in its entirety and replaced with the language below.
 "The County Agrees to pay the Contractor a total not to exceed sum of \$2,390,600.00, with an annual expenditure not to exceed \$478,120.00 per year for Goods and Services completed and accepted herein, payable on a fixed-fee basis for the deliverables as set out in Exhibit C, payable upon submittal of an invoice as required herein."
- Except as changed or modified herein, all provisions and conditions of the original Agreement and any amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.
