

**RESOLUTION 20-12**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, GRANTING STATUS TO SEMINOLE JUNIOR WARHAWKS ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, FOR DONATION OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY.

**WHEREAS**, PINELLAS COUNTY, hereinafter (“COUNTY”), has acquired, used, and maintained certain personal property in the form of miscellaneous equipment, (hereinafter the “PROPERTY”);

**WHEREAS**, said PROPERTY has reached the end of its useful life;

**WHEREAS**, the COUNTY, pursuant to Section 274.05 Florida State Statutes, may offer surplus PROPERTY to nonprofit agencies for donation;

**WHEREAS**, Seminole Junior Warhawks Athletic Association agrees to be designated as a recipient.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY FLORIDA, AT A DULY ASSEMBLED MEETING HELD ON THIS 10TH DAY OF MARCH, 2020, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The County, per Section 274.05, Florida State Statutes is authorized to donate surplus property.

**Section 2.** The County agrees to grant status to Seminole Junior Warhawks Athletic Association for donation of surplus property.

**Section 3.** The County will provide notice to Seminole Junior Warhawks Athletic Association of available surplus property in conjunction with notice provided to other designated recipients, and afford the possibility to acquire said surplus by donation, prior to the advertisement of the surplus items for sale to individuals or entities without said designation.

**Section 4.** The County may offer its surplus personal property directly to any designated recipient it deems proper, and upon rejection, may offer said property to the remainder of recipients.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
