Maximum Millage Rates



- Counties must establish maximum millage rates for certification to the Property Appraiser by July 30 [F.S. 200.065(2)b]
 - Maximum Millage Rates to be included in TRIM Notices
 - Millage Rates may be decreased after certification, but may not be increased
 - Millage Rate A rate applied to a property's taxable value to determine property tax due. As used with ad valorem (property) taxes, the rate expresses the dollars of tax per one thousand dollars of taxable value (a 5.0 mill tax on \$1,000 equals \$5.00).
 - Recommend that the Maximum Millage Rates be the FY24 Adopted Rates
