Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

This is the third amendment to the ambulance services contract with Paramedics Logistics Florida, LLC. This amendment removes the contractual requirement for Paramedics Logistics Florida, LLC to provide tactical paramedic services that are part of the ambulance contract. This service will now be provided thru the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office.

Under this amendment, payments to Paramedics Logistics Florida, LLC will be reduced by approximately \$7,500.00 per month (approximately \$90,000.00 per year). In addition, there are 2 tactical paramedic vehicles and emergency lighting equipment owned by Paramedics Logistics Florida, LLC that the County will purchase as it is used by the tactical paramedics. The cost to purchase the vehicles and lighting equipment is approximately \$56,500.00. Vehicle maintenance and replacement along with the future replacement of the lighting equipment will become recurring and future costs that the Emergency Medical Services Fund will be responsible for.

These changes have been included in the Emergency Medical Services Fund FY20 Estimate and FY21 Budget request.
