

Resolution No 25-133

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
PINELLAS COUNTY REVISING THE HONORARY NAMING RIGHTS
POLICIES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the naming or renaming of County-owned property and facilities is a legislative function of the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”), and the Board desires to provide a process and establish standards and criteria for presentation of naming rights proposals for consideration by the Board; and

WHEREAS, in reaching a determination as to the appropriate name for County property and facilities, consideration should be given to individuals, civic and charitable organizations, and other entities that have made substantial contributions to either the community, or to historical events relevant to the site of the property or facility, or to the geographic location of the property or facility, through civic involvement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, by Resolution 06-27 adopted February 7, 2006, previously approved honorary and philanthropic naming rights policies to provide a procedure for and criteria governing naming County property and facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to modify the existing Honorary Naming Rights Policy;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY at a duly assembled meeting held on this 18th day of November, 2025, as follows:

Section 1. The Honorary Naming Rights Policy attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby approved and adopted, and all proposed honorary naming rights recognizing either individuals, civic, or charitable groups, or other entities shall be considered and approved in accordance with this policy. The duly-adopted Philanthropic Naming Rights policy is separate and remains intact.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
