**Project Description (Include how the project will address the Goal and Objective identified above.)**

Replace and elevate electrical equipment at 35 sanitary sewer pump stations located along the coast of Pinellas County. Electrical equipment to be replaced and elevated includes the meter can, junction box, disconnect switch, remote telemetry unit and control panel. This equipment will be elevated on a new aluminum platform with stairs. New conduit and wire will feed power to the electrical equipment. The new electrical platforms will be installed 4 to 5 feet above existing grade and rated for 145 mph wind loads. The size, height, location and orientation of the elevated platforms will be based on the individual pump station sites, right-of-way and easement limitations. Bypass pumping will also be required to maintain flow during the work. The pump station numbers and locations are shown in Table 1 (attached). These pump stations are vulnerable to storm surge caused by major storm events which shut down sanitary sewer service to the coastal communities. Approximately 31,000 residents in Northern Pinellas County will benefit from this electrical improvement project.
