Review & Comments

This OMB Grants Team has conducted a review of the **Public Works** intent to apply for the **Safe Streets and Roads for All** funded by **U.S. Department of Transportation**.

Project Scope of Work

The proposed project seeks to improve emergency access along Keystone Road from East Lake Fire & Rescue Station 58 to East Lake Road. This intersection is identified as a "hot spot" in the Safe Streets Pinellas Action Plan. To be identified as a "hot spot" a segment or intersection needed to have a high proportion of collisions involving serious injuries or death occurring with the most frequency.

Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **multi-year** grant potentially affecting **FY28, FY29, FY30, FY31, & FY32**. The application request is for **\$7,960,000.00** with a **\$1,990,000.00** cost share requirement. The total project budget is **\$9,950,000.00**.
