We are working on the final version of the proposed ordinance changes especially pertaining to Pet Dealer Permitting. There has been concern about reducing the number of animals sold down to 1 litter annually to require a permit. We have added a section to the ordinance which is highlighted on the second page of the attachment. This new paragraph gives the pet owner selling the animals the option of getting a permit or having the female animal that birthed the litter sterilized in order to avoid a permit and citation.
