Date/Time/Comments: 12/21/2018 Approve and execute the Agreement with Pinellas County Ex-Offender Re-Entry Coalition, Inc. (PERC) for the Success Training and Retention Services (STARS) program. Did not require professional liability as agreement is for job training. Reviewed previous PERC contract 16-927D that included cyber liability requirement also.

NOTES: This Agreement provides funding to PERC to support and expand the STARS program. STARS will provide job training, support and placement for individuals whom are hard to place in employment. This funding will relaunch the program in North Pinellas County and allow for 80-100 participants in year one. Additionally, it provides for enhanced training with Pinellas Technical College or St. Petersburg College to assist with tiny house construction. Since mid-2017, there have been 73 successful completions and a placement rate of 70%.
