#### **EXPLAIN WHAT IS BEING REQUESTED**

• Approval of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport for the Criminal Justice Center complex parking areas.

#### **EXPLAIN WHY IT IS BEING REQUESTED AND ANY RELEVANT HISTORY ABOUT THIS REQUEST**

- Pursuant to Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements the Airport Revenue Fund must be compensated at full currently appraised Fair Market Value rental rates by governmental entities utilizing airport premises.
- As prescribed in Paragraph 3 of the Board Resolution No. 92-36, effective October 1, 2024, the annual rental rate in order to reflect current appraised fair market value is revised every five (5) years to reflect any increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index-Urban (CPI-U).
- An MOU has been in place since February 18, 1992.
- The current MOU expired on September 30, 2024.
- The new MOU term will be for a term of five years, expiring on September 30, 2029.
- The MOU annual rental rate, due on October 1 of each year, is revised every five years to reflect any increase or decrease in the Consumer Price Index-Urban (CPI-U).

### **EXPLAIN HOW THIS BENEFITS THE COUNTY**

• This MOU compensates the St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport for continued use of certain real property within the St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport, for the additional land for parking, for the County medium and maximum jail facilities, criminal court judicial facility, and for offices or the Public Defender, State Attorney, and Clerk of the Circuit Court, and for other related judicial and administrative functions.
