PROPOSED CHANGES

1. Revise Funding Categories & Eligibility
 2. Attendee & Visitor figures based on data gathered by VSPC
 3. Clarify allowable Marketing expenses & Broadcast viewership/assets
 4. One Year Only: Events may not reduce more than 50%
- 

USE OF FUNDING

1. Category 1 Events

- a. 100% of funds allocated towards Marketing and/or Sponsorship at VSPC's discretion

2. All Other Events

- a. 50% of funds allocated towards Marketing and/or Sponsorship at VSPC's discretion
 - b. 50% of funds towards event hosting fees with no restriction.

4	Meet requirements	7,500 Attendees & 40% of Attendees are Tourists	Up to \$50,000
5	Meet (1) of (2) requirements	5,000 Attendees & 40% of Attendees are Tourists -OR- 7,500 Attendees	Up to \$25,000
