Summary:

Claimant was hired by the Pinellas County Clerk of the Circuit Court in the civil records division on December 15, 2003. She was deemed to have voluntarily resigned from employment on July 24, 2013, after accruing more than three days of unauthorized absences in violation of then Pinellas County Personnel Rule XXII ("Unauthorized absences from work for a period of three (3) working days may be considered as the employee's voluntary resignation by the Appointing Authority").

On September 2, 2005, Claimant sustained an injury to her lower back when a co-worker collapsed causing Claimant to fall. Pinellas County has paid for Claimant's treatment under Workers' Compensation, the cost of which totals \$430,711.94 to date. Claimant has no other open Workers' Compensation claims. She is 44 years old.

As part and parcel to this negotiated settlement, Claimant will execute a general release and agree to a washout (meaning Claimant will no longer be treated through Workers' Compensation) for her September 2, 2005 date of injury.

Risk, County Administration and County Attorney staff met and reached the conclusion to recommend that the Board of County Commissioners accept this settlement in the amount of \$161,845.00.
