(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.) This resolution is a request to include the Sand Key 6th Nourishment project, 001516A, in the Florida Beach Management Funding Assistance Program Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Long-Range Budget Plan of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and apply for grant funding.

The Sand Key 6th Nourishment project, 001516A, is anticipated to have \$96,979,615.00 in construction and costs eligible for State grant funding. \$10,356,573.00 of which is covered with a Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) grant and requires zero match. Leaving \$86,623,042.00 in construction and \$466,000 in monitoring, or \$87,089,042.00 in eligible costs available for 50/50 cost sharing with FDEP. This is a funding request of \$43,544,521.00 to FDEP.

Construction and monitoring costs reflected in this resolution for Sand Key 6th Nourishment project, 001516A, are budgeted in the Proposed FY26-FY31 Capital Improvement Plan and funded by Tourist Development Tax (TDT) and a State grant with FDEM. If FDEP awards grant funding for Sand Key 6th Nourishment, project 001516A, this additional grant funding will offset TDT funding.
