



#### St. Petersburg Intown CRA Amendment

## **Background – Intown CRA**



- Created in 1982 with a TIF contribution @ 95%.
- Current City and County TIF contribution @ 50%.
- Interlocal Agreement and Plan last revised in 2018.
- 2019 Midterm Review concluded that contributions had been effectively utilized for planned projects and initiatives.
- Total County TIF contribution is capped at \$108.1 million that will not extend beyond FY 2032.



## Plan Update



- Extend the CRA and Redevelopment Trust Fund by 10 years to 2042.
- Increase the redevelopment budget from \$232.345 million to \$574.854 million:
  - ✓ 'New Stadium Project' totaling \$212.5 million (City TIF only).
  - ✓ 'Historic Gas Plant Redevelopment Infrastructure' totaling \$130 million (City TIF only).
- Allow the City to annually modify its TIF contribution up to 60% after 2032.
- Allow any remaining surplus County TIF to be utilized for debt service on the New Stadium Project so long as the Stadium Project is complete.
- No impact to the County's TIF contribution, which will remain at 50% with an overall cap of \$108.1 million that will not extend beyond FY 2032.

#### **Recommended Actions**



- Approve proposed amendments to the Intown Redevelopment Plan and the associated Interlocal Agreement between the County and City regarding the use of TIF funds in the CRA.
- City approved the amendments on July 18, 2024.
- Approval would be the final extension to complete the statutory maximum 60-year lifespan of the CRA.

### **Recommended Actions**



- Approve proposed amendments to the Pinellas County Code to conform it to the proposed revisions to the CRA Plan and Interlocal Agreement.
- Code is limited in scope to the County's contributions to the Redevelopment Trust Fund.
- The County's contributions are unchanged and will terminate when either a defined total contribution amount is reached (\$108.1 million), or the County makes is FY 2032 payment to the fund, whichever occurs first.
