It was discussed, at length, the problems that will occur at the entrance/exit of Coral Way once the six/seven lanes are in operation.

The problem of only being able to turn right, cross three lanes of traffic; a short distance, to the next available U-Turn then cross three lanes of traffic again if you wish to go north on Belcher Road . The problems also for ambulatory patrons crossing seven lanes of traffic to get to the bus stop on the south side of the road to go west. The walk to the light at Belcher and Ulmerton is too far (1/4 mile each way), for mothers with strollers in 90 + degree heat. They will of course, jaywalk! The possibility of accidents, personal injury or even death is very high.

It was discussed and reviewed whether or nor it was possible to open 139th Avenue through to Belcher Road. Both Duke Energy and Pinellas would look into easements, financial cost, accessibility etc.

Possible use of Duke Energy easement (Power lines field) adjacent to 139th Avenue

Duke Energy will look into the possibility of Coral Heights Neighborhood Association renting, leasing or purchasing the field for the children to be able to have a playing field/sport area, recreation area. Jay is to be advised when Melisa and Doug have done some research.

Jay is to research the insurance requirements required by Duke Energy.
