**RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINAL MILLAGE
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022
PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the governing body and taxing authority for the Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services Authority, has adopted a tentative millage to be levied upon property under its jurisdiction and a tentative budget in accordance with the fiscal policy of the Board of County Commissioners and Florida Statutes at a public hearing on 9th day of September, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that the final millage and final budget are at the lowest possible level in accordance with sound fiscal policy; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to adopt the final millage has been published and the Board has conducted a public hearing on the adoption of the final millage pursuant to the requirements of Chapters 129 and 200, Florida Statutes, and other applicable provisions of Florida Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners sitting as the governing body and taxing authority for the Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services Authority, in public hearing duly assembled this 21st day of September, 2021, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the final millage rate for the Pinellas County Emergency Medical Services Authority as established pursuant to said hearing for the fiscal year 2021-2022 as **0.9158** mills, which millage rate represents a **6.38%** increase in property taxes for the said fiscal year over the rolled-back rate of **0.8609**.
