Date/Time/Comments: 03/08/2017 Rick Kahler Approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Letter of Agreement (LOA) with the State of Florida's Agency for Healthcare Administration (AHCA), on behalf of local hospital providers, for the Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) and Medicaid Low Income Pool (LIP) programs. There are no insurance requirements. Previous approval for delegation of authority was under contract 16-557A

NOTES: On May 24, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the use of up to \$10.1 million dollars for Intergovernmental Transfers (IGTs) to AHCA for the Low Income Pool (LIP) and DSH programs. Human Services recently received notification of an opportunity to assist with DSH and LIP on behalf of St. Anthony's Hospital. The current LOA is for a total of \$2,400,000.00.

The LOA details the arrangement for the County to provide the IGT to AHCA to increase the provision of health services for charity care to local hospitals through the DSH and LIP program. The IGT from the County will help provide for additional funding enhancements for participating hospitals.
