Description & Comments

This is for the approval of the Eighth Amendment to the agreement with Carousel Industries of North America for maintenance and repair of 9-1-1 equipment. This contract provides a mechanism for the Safety and Emergency Services department to receive contract services for maintenance and repair of the VESTA 911 phone system. The Amendment extends the current contract and will exercise the second 12 months extension of the 24-month extension period through February 11, 2026, and increases the contract by \$3,944,964.05 which includes a Pinellas 911 - St Pete Vesta Refresh, additional Network Hardware & Pro Services for Network Redundancy and continued maintenance and repair for a revised total contract value of \$9,458,519.28.

The \$3,944,964.05 funds is consistent and included in the FY25 Adopted Budget. The funding is derived from the Emergency Communications E911 System fund.
